STAFF CADET PART II TRAINING

INTRODUCTION

Successful completion of the Staff Cadet examination means that a cadet has completed all of his or her own training and is ready, under the squadron officers, to assist fully in the running of the squadron and to assume responsibility for various activities.

The oral examination is knowledge of the Corps, squadron administration and supply procedures, and together with the test of instructional or organizational ability, covers a wide area. During the Staff Part II course we will discuss the important parts of these subjects with which you, as a potential Staff Cadet, should be reasonably familiar. Study the course notes and use them to enrich your experience in your own squadron. You may not be able to memorise it all but if you cannot answer a question, the notes will help you to know where to look for the answer. The answer to most questions arising in your squadron can be found in one or other of the relevant publications.

It is most important that you appreciate that much of the detail – such as the precise references quoted – will become out of date as amendments to detailed procedures are made. The first thing to do in case of doubt is to look in ACP 20A and ACP 20B. Both ACPs are regularly reviewed and amended as required.

Within the Warwickshire and Birmingham Wing the Staff Cadet Part II examination is conducted in the form of a Wing course. See you Training Officer for a list of available dates
